For Dr. Herb Mattord, Associate Professor with the Coles College of Business at Kennesaw State University, ensuring students' safety abroad is a top priority. Besides that, it was also important to make sure the parents felt that the program maintained quick and efficient communication with their children.

In addition to finding an industry-leading solution to maintain the safety of students traveling abroad, finding a platform that was simple enough to teach students in the classroom, yet robust enough to represent what they would actually experience on the job was a priority for Michael Whitman, Professor of Information Security and Assurance's Incident Response and Disaster Recovery classes at Kennesaw State University.

TEACHING WITH PREPARIS: THE ACADEMIC PERSPECTIVE

Incident response and disaster recovery is a critical component of the information technology industry. Dr. Whitman, who teaches incident response and disaster recovery planning classes on a graduate and undergraduate level at Kennesaw State University stated, "For several years I've looked for a real-world, industry-leading application that was simple enough to teach students within the course of a semester, yet robust enough to represent what students would experience on the job. Students are set up with their own locations and go through several simulated emergency events per semester, where they complete all of the necessary steps to notify their "employees" of a crisis situation, such as sending out notifications, tracking their incidents and posting policies and plans in the Preparis portal.
